Application

LOBACTEN SANITIZER is a sanitizing compound that is effective at 1 ounce per 4 gallons of water. This broad spectrum, sanitizer is commonly used in restaurants for sanitizing hand washed dishes and in food processing plants for sanitizing all food contact equipment, and surfaces.

LOBACTEN SANITIZER deodorizes those areas, which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, pet areas and any other areas, which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

- Used to sanitize dishes and glassware in restaurants and bars when used at 200ppm which is 1 oz. in 4 gallons of water.
